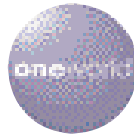




## SOMEONE SPECIAL AT AMERICAN

### TAKING CARE OF EACH OTHER

On the second and third Saturday of each month, Rob Britton, American's managing director of advertising, joins a team of other volunteers from the Dallas Ramp Project. By noon on those days, the group will have completed six to 10 wheelchair ramps for people who cannot afford them. Since 1985, the Dallas Ramp Project has built more than 950 ramps for residents of Dallas and its suburbs. Churches, corporate partners, and individual donors provide funding for the materials (an average ramp uses about \$250 in lumber). The project has no paid staff. Rob has been involved for seven years, and says that in all his years of volunteering for different causes, this work is the most gratifying he's ever done. "It fills a huge human need," he said. "The people we help are imprisoned in their houses because of a two-foot drop. In three hours we can make an enormous difference in a person's life." Rob also enjoys the camaraderie among volunteers. There was a time, he laments, when communities gathered often to help others, but "there are no barn raisings anymore." Thanks to the efforts of people like Rob, fellow AAer Lisa Welch, and a host of other volunteers, the Project will complete ramp number 1,000 on a very special Saturday in late fall.
