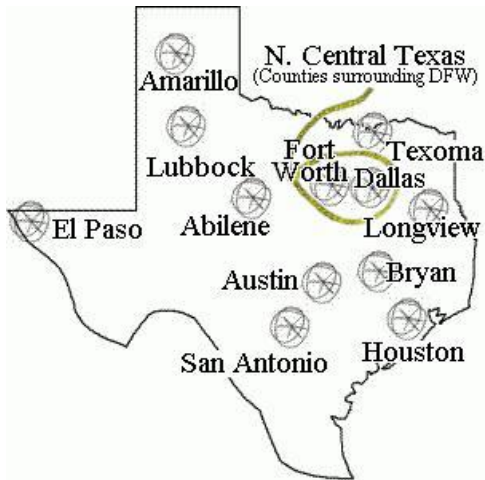


WHO WE ARE

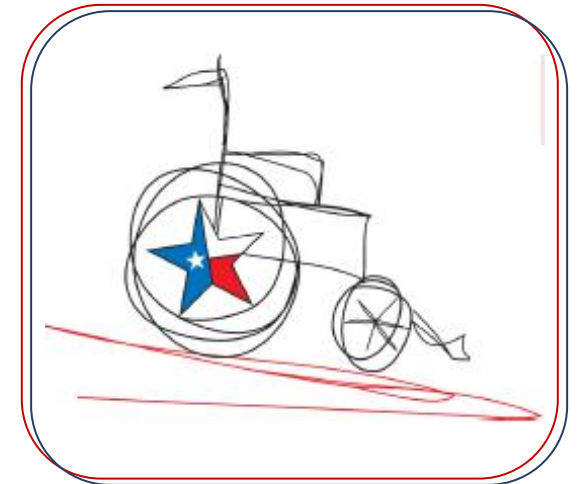

 - Expected to double by 2010
- 20.4% of age 20-64 is disabled
- 7.6% of age 5 to 20 is disabled

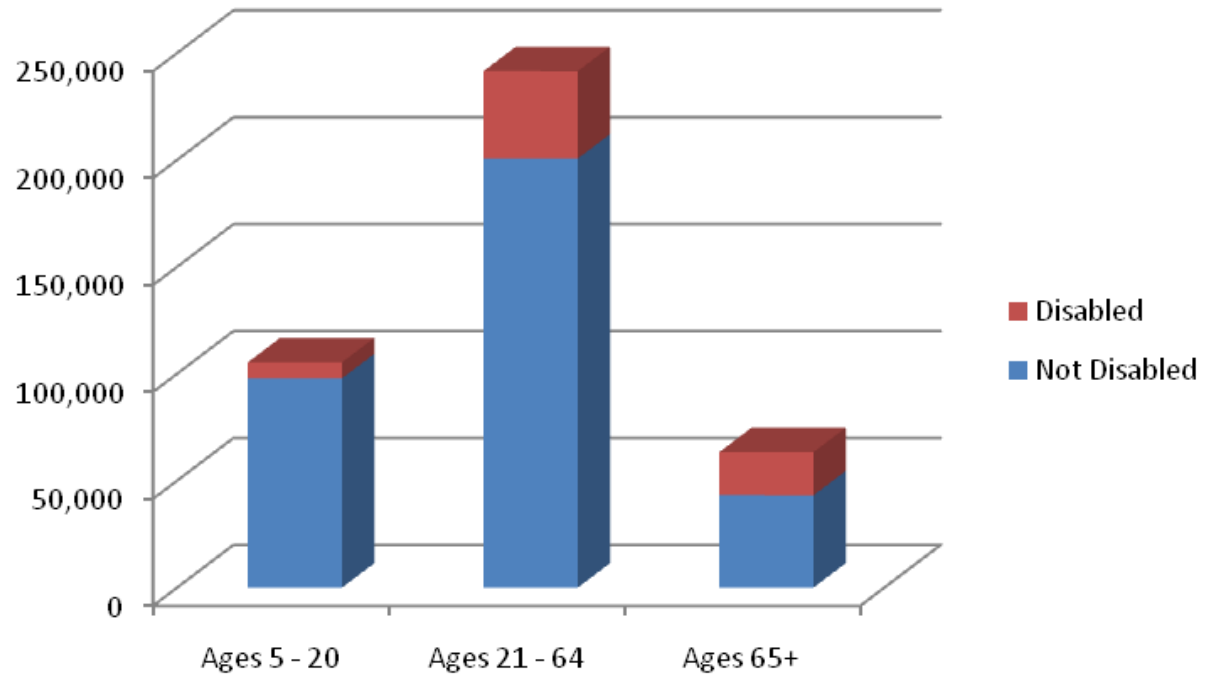
