Dear Friends,

After the newsletter went out, we received the following from Larry Baird, Austin Central; Williamson County. As it is a very doable plan for reopening his region, we thought it would be good to pass on for your consideration as your region gears up to build.

“We will return to ramp building effective May 16, building 4 ramps in May. I have reviewed the Williamson county directives and we are well within their requirements.

The following have been established as procedures to be adhered to in May:

1. The maximum team size will be 9 members.
2. All team participants are to wear masks except when drinking water, where they should distance themselves from the other members.
3. When possible, they should work in pairs, maximizing their distance from other workers. No congregating around problem areas. Let the members working on the problem resolve their own issues.
4. Disinfectant towels or disinfectant and towels will be provided to wipe down equipment handles if desired.
5. Disinfectant will be provided to use freely as desired.
6. Minimize contact with client and maintain the proper distance if there is the need to converse with them.

Hopefully this can be relaxed in June.
